### **SHORT SYNOPSIS**

A story of childhood friends navigating life in the urban landscape of Tbilisi, where even the simplest everyday moments become inevitably political. In 2024, protests are held on the streets of Tbilisi against the so-called "Foreign Agents" law. Tina, Luka, director Tiku and their friends also take part. They resist by being there for one another – gathering courage for what lies ahead. A portrait of youth standing at the cusp of leaving childhood behind intertwined with the daily struggle of fighting against a regime determined to strip its people of their freedom.

A Bittersweet tale of change, devotion, resilience, and the fleeting sweetness of freedom — here and now.

### **DIRECTOR'S NOTE**

I find my reflections in my city, in my friends and the places I hold dear. I align myself with the camera, I allow it to become both my weapon and my shield. My subjects, shaped by their involvement in Tbilisi's political transformations, create a collective portrait for all young people of Georgia, myself included. Auto ethnography becomes a practice of adaptation — a way to get used to the rhythms, forces, and currents that are shaping the ordinary of our social life at this very moment.
