SUNSET OVER AMERICA — Atardecer En America — is produced by Françoise Nieto-Fong and Tomas Gerlach Mora through their companies Centauro and A Simple Vista. Award-winning Chilean filmmaker Matías Rojas Valencia directs. The short film will have its world premiere at the 75th edition of the Berlinale, in the Generation 14Plus section, celebrating works that challenge, inspire, and connect with young audiences worldwide. Sebastian Markt, Head of Generation 14 highlighted its depth and originality:

"We were impressed with how the film, in its images, narration and montage manages to not only give an account of an individual journey of migration, but casts a wider glance at a regime of borders. Between images of sharp observation and images of evocation, we can form an understanding of borders not only as physical things, but as a violent social fact. It's a quiet, but all the more searing form of political cinema."

Through its unique visual approach and deeply introspective narrative, Sunset over America reflects, with delicacy and strength, on the human and spiritual complexities of migratory journeys in one of the most inhospitable territories in Latin America, the border between Bolivia and Chile opening a dialogue on the migration crisis and the human and political implications of borders in Latin America.

SYNOPSIS

15-year-old Barbara leaves behind the crisis in Venezuela and embarks on a journey across South America to reach the coast of Chile. She recalls the night she crossed the Andean Plateau at 4,000 meters above sea level, struggling against biting cold and exhaustion but guided by a spiritual presence that wandered like the wind. This otherworldly landscape of snowcapped mountains, wild alpacas, crystal clear streams, and parched stretches of desert between Bolivia and Chile make up one of the most dangerous migrant routes in Latin America. Amidst desolation, one thing remains clear to Barbara: she must never give up.

DIRECTOR - MATIAS ROJAS VALENCIA

His first feature, "*Raíz*", premiered internationally at the San Sebastián Film Festival, won Best Chilean Film at the Valdivia Film Festival, and was selected an impressive list of film festivals: Havana, Cartagena de Indias, BAFICI, Palm Springs, Nuovo Cinema de Pesaro, Tübingen, Málaga, New York, Glasgow Film Festival, and Miami. He produced the short film "*Necesito Saber*" with the Factory Program grant of the Cannes Film Festival, which had its international premiere during the Directors' Fortnight.

His second feature film, "Un Lugar Llamado Dignidad" a co-production between Chile, France, Germany, Argentina, and Colombia, was selected for the French CNC Aide aux Cinémas du Monde fund, the Ibermedia fund, the Chile-Argentina bilateral co-production fund, the Hamburg fund, and Chilean audiovisual production and distribution grants. The film premiered in the international competition of the Tallinn Film Festival.

His scripts and film projects have been selected for various international development platforms: San Sebastián Film Festival, Produire au Sud residency, Berlinale Co-Production Market, Venice Production Bridge, and L'Atelier de la Cinéfondation at the Cannes Film Festival, among others.

Currently, he is developing "Patas de Perro", an adaptation of the classic book of the same name by Carlos Droguett. This narrative feature has been awarded Chile's production fund and is co-produced with Colombia's Rhayuela Films.

PRODUCER – FRANÇOISE NIETO-FONG

Producer, writer, and distributor. Early in her career, she acquired and distributed independent films for theatrical release in Colombia.

Her first feature-length documentary, Los Archivos Privados de Pablo Escobar, was released in USA, Colombia, France, and Spain, and acquired by HBO and A&E.

She has produced series, short films, concerts, documentaries, and realities for Fox, Aljazeera, National Geographic, Cinemark, MTV, Señal Colombia, El Gourmet, Telesur. Her recent credits include the hybrid documentary feature "Aullido de Invierno" which premiered at Tallinn Black Nights, participated in Cinelatino Toulouse, won Best Film at SANFIC 2024, and was selected for Trieste, FIDBA, and Message to Man. She is currently developing the fourth season of her podcast Mujeres Al Desnudo and developing a slate of feature films with Matías Rojas Valencia.

As a distributor, she has worked extensively in Europe through her long-standing association with the Netherlands-based Skoop Media.

PRODUCER – TOMÁS GERLACH MORA

A graduate of the University of Chile's Film and TV School, he founded A Simple Vista in 2012.

He co-produced: "El Vals de los Inútiles" by Edison Cájas Cájas (nominated for Best Ibero-American Documentary at the Platino Awards) and participated in the Mar del Plata Film Festival, American Documentary Film Festival, Biarritz Film Festival.

He produced Matías Rojas Valencia's hybrid documentary-fiction "Aullido de Invierno", which was awarded the Chilean Audiovisual Fund 2022 and participated in the Tallinn Film Festival 2021 co-production Market and Cannes Docs.

The film premiered at Tallinn Black Nights, and was selected for Cinelatino Toulouse, and was selected for Trieste, FIDBA, and Message to Man. The film won Best Film at SANFIC 2024.

He is now developing Carlos Leiva's third feature film, "Raíz Podrida", and "Patas de Perro", written by Matías Rojas Valencia. Based on Carlos Droguett's novel, it has already been awarded Chilean development and production funds, the IFI regional fund from CORFO, and is co-produced by Colombia's Rhayuela, led by international producer Federico Durán.

Additionally, Gerlach is involved in the development of "Piñen", a feature film by director Carolina Moscoso, based on the book of the same name by Mapuche-Chilean writer Daniela Catrileo.
