Logline

At a barbecue, Ryan's five-year-old son briefly goes missing. Ryan's violent reaction to this scare sets off a chain of events and unearths secrets from the past. A journey of self-discovery and forgiveness begins.

Short Synopsis

In Cape Town, a group of friends are having a barbecue. The day is disrupted when Ryan's son goes missing. Taking place over one weekend, this sparks a series of incidents which puts a strain on Ryan, his friendships, and his marriage. Ryan's destructive actions while desperately searching for his son spark more arguments and unknown events from the past are revealed, while Ryan continues to find himself in difficult situations, despite his best intentions.

The Heart Is A Muscle is a humanist drama about generational healing and forgiveness, and a man learning that in order to be a better father, husband and friend, he must first learn to forgive himself.

Long Synopsis

The Heart Is A Muscle follows Ryan and his group of close friends - all in their mid-30's - celebrating his son's 5th birthday party. Ryan, kind but with a dark past, is a doting father to Jude. Ryan and Laila, his wife, have their hands full today. His close friends and their partners are over for a barbecue, the football is on soon, kids running amok, all the while friends laughing and catching up. The pleasant day, however, is disrupted when Jude goes missing.

Nervy frustration quickly escalates, panic ensues. The house has been searched top to bottom. He is not here. The search begins. It's frantic and everyone is concerned. Someone goes to the local park; another canvasses the grocery stores in the surrounding area. Frantic calls are made while the police still haven't arrived. As the minutes tick by, some in the group begin to grow agitated. The seriousness of the situation reveals parts of themselves they haven't shown before. A call arrives: Jude was seen in a nearby neighbourhood ruled by gangs. Ryan arrives and beats up a local man, Andre, after wrongly suspecting he might be involved. It begins to feel desperate.

After a short while, Jude is found. He had been hiding nearby and innocently thought this was a funny prank. Ryan arrives and immediately slaps his son across the face. This sparks another furious row between the friends and couples. They now start to really turn on each other. Unknown events from the past are brought up and secrets of Ryan's past are partially revealed.

That evening Andre returns and demands money, or he will go to the police. Andre too has a 5-year-old son, named Lesley. Ryan pays him but he is now also filled with guilt and shame. Ryan then takes it upon himself to help Andre in his daily life, maybe help him be a better father, but Ryan is really trying to fix himself too. While spending time together it is revealed Ryan and Andre know each other through a violent incident which happened when they were teenagers in which Ryan was the perpetrator. This only deepens Ryan wanting to remedy his actions, past and present. But he falls further and has a breakdown, revealing his secret to Laila. This allows him to be closer to his wife and for the first time deal with his past actions and the violence passed to him from his father.

But when Andre disappears for a night, Ryan takes it upon himself to look after Lesley. In doing so, has unknowingly kidnapped someone else's child. Realising the situation, he and Laila call the police. After they arrive, Andre knocks on the door looking for his son. This sparks a furious argument between everybody, each blaming the other for negligence, amongst other things. After resisting threats of arrest, with the help of his son's new friendship with Andre's kid Lesley, Ryan makes peace with himself and his actions and volunteers to go into police custody and, in doing so, takes responsibility for his actions.

The Heart Is A Muscle is a hip-hop influenced, humanist drama about a young father trying to be the best version of himself while trying to overcome his past and present actions.

THE HEART IS A MUSCLE was inspired by an incident that happened at a friend's barbecue in much the same way it does in the film. My friend's kid was found very quickly but this got me thinking about this moment in my life when my friends and I entered a very new, very adult stage of our lives. We're at a moment where we're now facing some of the similar challenges our parents had faced, albeit in a very different world.

My intention is to make a film about a man trying to be the best version of himself in a difficult situation. Because of some of the things he's done, the way he's acted in the past, he is filled with guilt and shame. We watch his journey as he slowly discovers that to become the person he wants to be, he needs to learn to forgive himself.

With a key theme of the film being the role of fathers in our lives, I am looking to explore not just intergenerational trauma, but also generational healing and forgiveness. I am not looking to justify problematic behaviour; I am instead trying to explore questions that are difficult to answer in a single sentence. In the end, I want to examine the characters and relationships with compassion, without judgement.

This film is my attempt at deconstructing masculinity and a way for me to wrestle with these questions but also try to be non judgemental about the characters and the choices they make. To treat Ryan as a complex person who needs time to figure out this new stage of his life while still trying to overcome his past.

IMRAN HAMDULAY – Producer / Writer / Director

Imran Hamdulay is a writer and director based in Cape Town, South Africa. He is a Berlinale Talents alumni & Film Independent fellow. He was the recipient of the Robert Bosch Stiftung award and was featured on CNN Inside Africa as one of Africa's directors to watch. His debut feature, "The Heart Is A Muscle," premiered at the 75th Berlin International Film Festival. His most recent short film, "The Wait," (2023) premiered at the 3rd edition of the Red Sea International Film Festival and won best short film at the 45th Durban International Film Festival.

Imran also produced the crime-thriller "Sons of the Sea," (2021) which premiered at Cinequest (USA). The film went on to win Best Feature Film at the 43rd Durban International Film Festival. His screenplays have featured at various international markets including IFFR Producer's Lab, Cannes Marche du Film, EAVE and Gotham Film Week amongst others.

KHOSIE DALI - Producer

Khosie Dali is a Cape Town-based film producer and the founder of Miss K Productions, a boutique production house specializing in narrative fiction.

Khosie's producing journey is built on a foundation of experience shaped by prestigious programs and fellowships. She is a Global Media Maker Fellow and an alumnus of acclaimed initiatives such as the Rotterdam Lab, EAVE Producers Lab, and the Realness Institute.

Her debut film, "Sons of the Sea," (2021) a gripping crime thriller, premiered at CineQuest in Los Angeles and won the Best South African Film Award at the 43rd Durban International Film Festival.

Khosie recently produced her second feature, "The Heart Is A Muscle," directed by Imran Hamdulay, which is set to have its international premiere at Berlinale.

Her upcoming feature, "Vlees," explores the story of a family grappling with the aftermath of a 1994 car accident that claimed their daughter's life and left the mother quadriplegic. Her latest project in development, "Eziko," follows a young academic's journey to the Eastern Cape in search of her long-lost sister.
